The German red cross Tracing Service, through ist counseling centers and tracing stations, provides comprehensive serices for ethnic German repatriates.

Repatriates

We provide guidance to you and your family on all matters related to the Federal Expellees Act (BVFG), the Residence Act (AufenthG), and the Nationality Act (StAG).

Refugees

We offer advice on the legal requirements for **family reunification** to Germany and assist you throughout the visa process.

Through the global Red Cross network, **family messages** (Red Cross Messages) can be exchanged, even when other means of communication (telephone, email, social media, mail) are unavailable.

Reuniting

The GRC Tracing Service advises and supports relatives who are seperated by armed conflict, disaster, flight, expulsion or migration in reuniting families in Germany.



Connecting

The GRC Tracing Service enables the exchange of messages between relatives who have lost contact to each other and cannot communicate using conventional means.
